

Wood Carving Workshop at Sainik School Bijapur

A four-day wood carving workshop is being organized for the art enthusiasts at Sainik School Bijapur from 1-4 Sep, 2017.

The workshop was inaugurated on Friday, 1 Sep by Principal Col Tamojeet Biswas. Nearly 30 students belonging to art club will participate in this workshop which will enlighten the students about various aspects of wood carving art. The closing function will be held at 10.30 am on Monday, 4 Sep.

The workshop is being organized by Sainik School Bijapur for the aspiring artists. Eminent artist Chandrahas Jatihal is conducting the workshop to teach basics of wood carving in order to make wood blocks. He will be assisted by the artists from Kalburgi- Ms. Pooja Chinde and Ms. Nayana B. They will teach the techniques and skills through which the young artists can create artwork according to their perception and creativity.

Speaking on the occasion, Principal Col Tamojeet Biswas said that such workshops are need of the hour to inculcate the values of artistic skills in young aspirants in this era of technical revolution. Carving with wood is skill and it has been practised since ages. Even today it has its own charm among art lovers. This will be an interactive workshop between the artistes and students wherein they can learn different techniques and ideas of woodcraft.

The workshop is about the designs to be carved over wood and giving it a charming effect. At the four-day long workshop, the participants are creating different wood blocks for creating art work on paper as well as clothes. Their creation will be put up at an exhibition to mark the conclusion of the workshop.
